## **Literary Reference Center™ Plus**

*Literary Reference Center™ Plus* is the ultimate online literary resource, providing users with a broad spectrum of information on thousands of authors and their works across literary disciplines and timeframes. This full-text database combines information from major respected reference works, books and literary journals, as well as original content from EBSCO Publishing.

Full-text content contained within *Literary Reference Center Plus* includes:

- More than 35,000 plot summaries, synopses and work overviews
- Nearly 100,000 articles/essays of literary criticism
- More than 259,000 author biographies
- Over 675 literary journals
- More than 704,000 book reviews

## **Humanities International Complete™**

*Humanities International Complete™* provides full text of hundreds of journals, books and other published sources from around the world. Produced by Whitston Publishing (an imprint of EBSCO Publishing), this database includes:

- All data from *Humanities International Index™* (more than 2,300 journals and 2.9 million records)
- Unique full-text content (for more than 1,200 journals), much of which is not found in other databases



## **MLA International Bibliography**

*MLA International Bibliography* offers a detailed bibliography of journal articles, books and dissertations. Produced by the Modern Language Association (MLA), the electronic version of the bibliography dates back to the 1920s and contains over 2.3 million citations from more than 4,400 journals & series, and 1,000 book publishers.

The indexed materials coverage is international and includes almost 60 titles from J-STOR's language and literature collection as well as links to full text. This database includes journal abbreviations and acronyms for almost 3,500 titles, with full journal names standardized and ISSNs attached. *MLA International Bibliography* also contains nearly 11,000 subject names and terms.

Subjects consist of literature, language and linguistics, folklore, literary theory & criticism, dramatic arts, as well as the historical aspects of printing and publishing. Listings on rhetoric and composition and the history, theory and practice of teaching language and literature are also included.

In addition to the bibliography, the database includes the *MLA Directory of Periodicals*; the association's proprietary thesaurus used to assign descriptors to each record in the bibliography; and a proprietary, searchable directory of noted authors' names, with links to brief descriptive notes.
